Lakewood Lodge is a charitable, Christian, non-profit facility founded by Reverend and Mrs. Albert Earle, who were involved in full-time ministry for over 60 years. Upon retiring to Maine in the late 1970's, the Earles saw the need for a facility that would primarily serve Bible-believing churches, groups, and individuals for Christian-related activities. Lakewood Lodge was constructed in 1991 to meet this need. The facility has been used by diverse Christian denominations from Maine to Alabama.

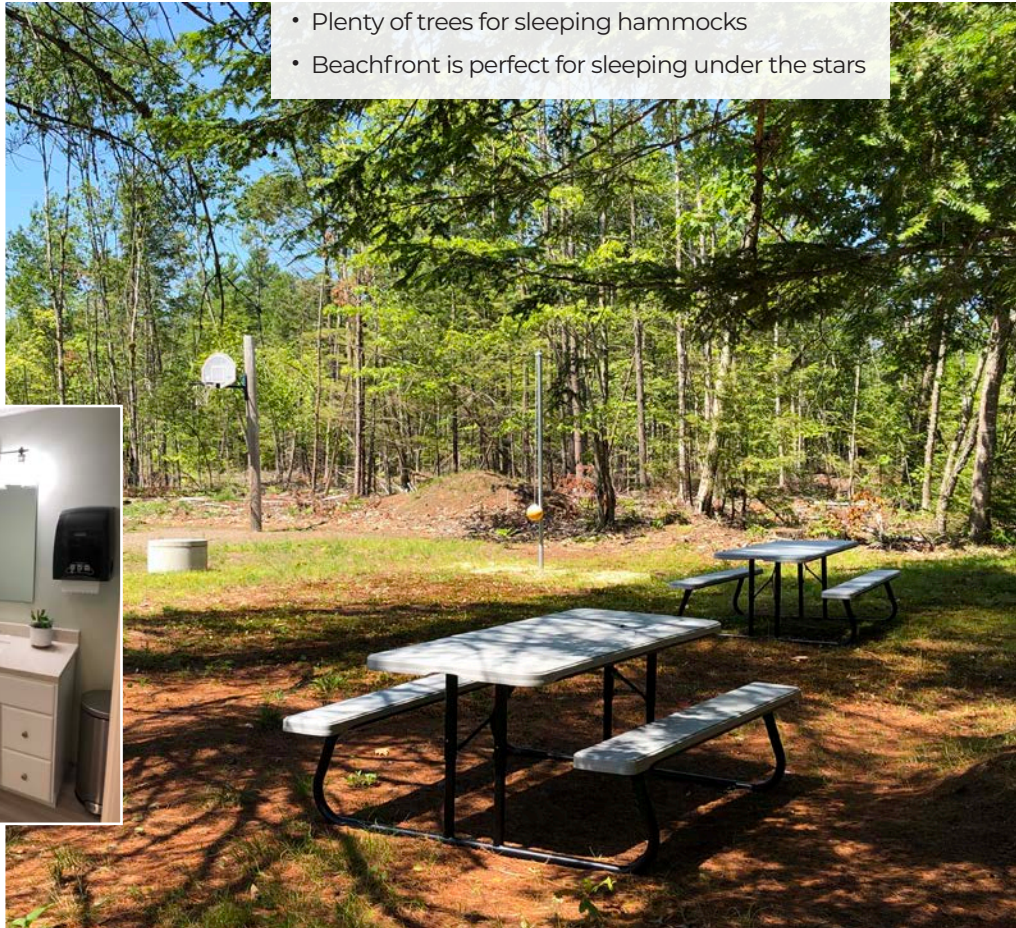

- \$20 per night

- \$200 per day, or any reasonable portion of a day, includes use of the downstairs main facility, kitchen, grill, recreational and beach areas

- \$10 per room cleaning charge



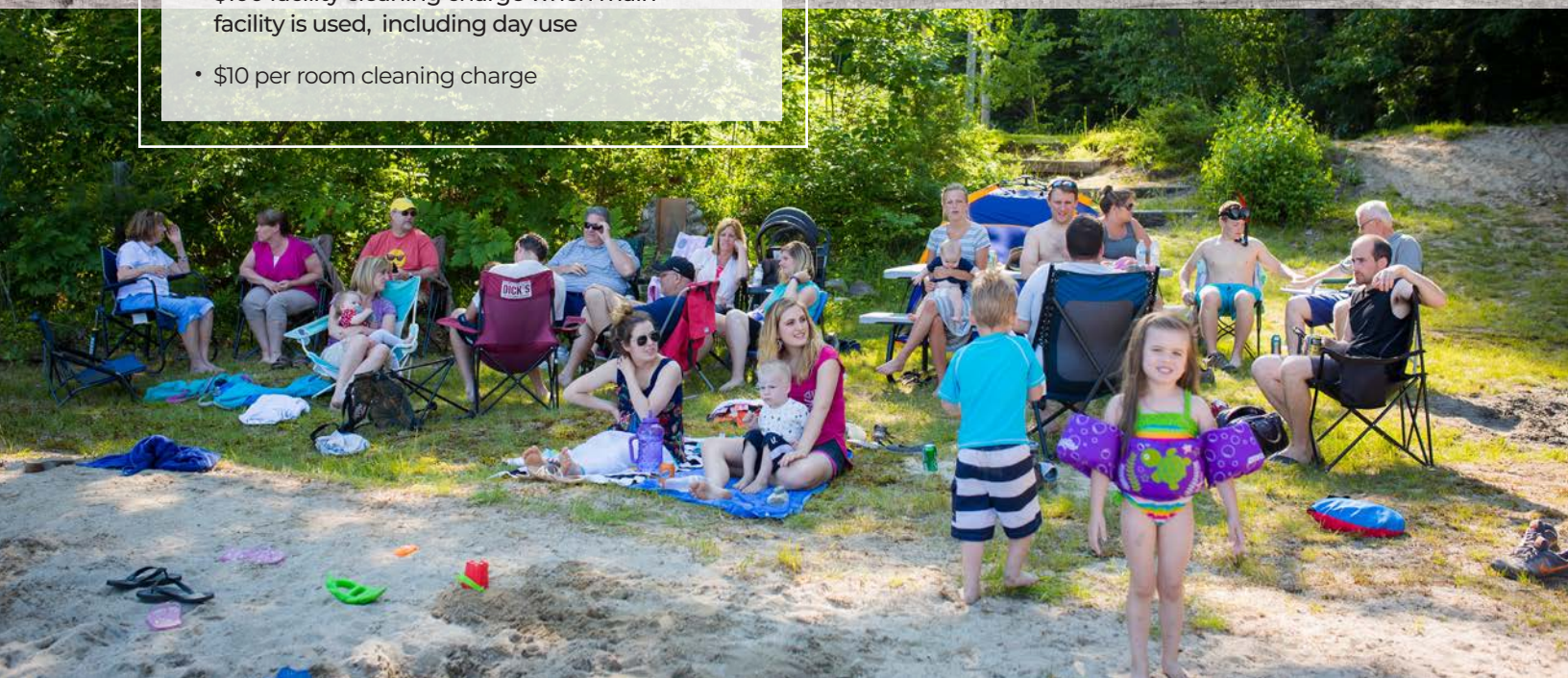
